## RESOLUTION

Whereas the preparations for the strategic arms limitation talks have involved the most intensive study of strategic arms problems ever made by the Government of the United States of America or any other government;

Whereas the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics open talks on April 16, 1970, which could result in agreement to limit arms and other matters: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives hereby  
2 expresses its unreserved support for the talks which begin  
3 April 16, 1970, on the limitations of strategic arms between

1 the Government of the United States of America and the  
2 Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics; be it  
3 further

4 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the House of Represent-  
5 atives that—

6 (1) prompt negotiations between the Governments  
7 of the United States of America and of the Union of  
8 Soviet Socialist Republics to seek agreed limitations  
9 of both offensive and defensive strategic weapons should  
10 be urgently pursued; and

11 (2) the President should in such negotiations pro-  
12 pose to the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist  
13 Republics an immediate suspension by the United States  
14 and by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics of the  
15 further deployment of all offensive and defensive nuclear  
16 strategic weapons systems, subject to national verifica-  
17 tion or such other measures of observation and inspection  
18 as may be appropriate.
