In view of the interest you expressed in the School Lunch and Special Milk Programs, I am happy to report to you that yesterday the House voted to restore the funds which the Administration had drastically cut from the Federal Budget for fiscal 1967.

I was pleased to be able to support restoration of the funds and to vote for the appropriation bill because, in my judgment, the two programs have been extremely effective in providing for the health and welfare of school children. This should be a primary concern of government at all levels and I am encouraged that Congress will continue to contribute toward this objective.
