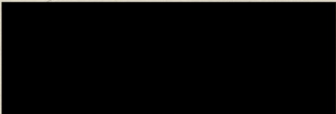

Dear Mr. [REDACTED]:

Thank you for writing me and expressing your agreement with my views on the complex problem of inflation and its causes.

I am very much opposed to the two bills referred to in your letter pertaining to the Rural Electrification Administration. I agree with you wholeheartedly that government subsidy of REA loans should be eliminated. The REA has become highly competitive with private utilities and the original purpose of REA is long past.

You might be interested in knowing that in the ten years I have been in Congress, I have never voted to expand the REA. I believe in ~~private~~ private enterprise and oppose any encroachment of competitive government-subsidized projects.
