## IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

MARCH 17, 1971

Mr. HOLIFIELD (for himself, Mrs. DWYER, Mr. GARMATZ, Mr. HORTON, Mr. ROSENTHAL, Mr. ERLBORN, Mr. WRIGHT, Mr. WYDLER, Mr. ST GERMAIN, Mr. BROWN of Ohio, Mr. FUQUA, and Mr. MOORHEAD) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Government Operations

## A BILL

To extend the period within which the President may transmit to Congress reorganization plans concerning agencies of the executive branch of the Federal Government, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That subsection (b) of section 905 of title 5 of the United  
4       States Code is amended by striking out "April 1, 1971",  
5       and inserting in lieu thereof "April 1, 1973".

6       SEC. 2. Subsection (b) of section 903 of title 5 of the  
7       United States Code is amended by inserting after "and to  
8       each House while it is in session" the following: ", and

1 furthermore shall not transmit more than one such plan to  
2 Congress within any period of thirty consecutive days”.

3 SEC. 3. Subsection (a) of section 905 of title 5 of the  
4 United States Code is amended by striking out “or” at the  
5 end of paragraph (5), and by striking out the period at the  
6 end of paragraph (6) and inserting in lieu thereof “; or”,  
7 and by adding after paragraph (6) the following new  
8 paragraph:

9 “(7) dealing with more than one logically consist-  
10 ent subject matter.”
