A BILL

To prohibit federally insured banks from making unsolicited commitments to extend credit, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 Section 1. The Federal Deposit Insurance Act is
- 4 amended by adding the following new section at the end:
- 5 "Sec. 22. (a) No insured bank may issue any credit
- 6 card unless—
- 7 "(1) the person to whom the card is issued has
- 8 requested that it be issued to him; and
- 9 "(2) the amount of credit which may be outstand-
- ing at any time as a result of transactions involving the
- card is limited to a maximum dollar amount specified in
