Dear Sir

I find by the differences amongst those who are bound to contribute to the payment of the Duncan debt, that there is no probability of receiving what is now due ^{for interest} immediately, or of being paid with punctuality, the ~~interest~~ future interest. I have therefore, according to your instructions, commenced proceedings for the collection of principal and interest, the whole of which stands perfectly secure under the mortgage & judgment ag^t Mr Duncan. The mis- take between Capt Duncan, & Messrs Schuyler & Bayler, in the omission of the principal of the two bonds for interest, when settling between themselves the amount due to you, does not affect your security.

Mrs Henry desires to join with me in our best wishes to Mrs Kean & yourself.
