That I John Faucheraud Grimké of  
Charlestown in the State aforesaid Esqr.

For and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifteen  
Thousand pounds lawful

current Money of  
the state aforesaid to me in Hand paid at and  
before the Sealing and Delivery of these Presents by  
John Kean of Beaufort in the state  
aforesaid the Receipt whereof I do hereby  
Presents do bargain, sell and deliver to the said John Kean  
All those several Negroe slaves named as follows viz.  
Cato Sampson Sandy Guinea Peter, September June  
Edinborough Sancho December Primus [Cera] Gloster  
Kate Affy Flora Minna Moll Peter Venus Lettice Doll  
Hannah Ben Joe Rinah Venus Mariane & Bess

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Negroe Slaves  
+ the future Issue & increase of the said female  
Slaves

unto the said John Kean his  
Executors, Administrators and Assigns, to his and their  
only proper Use and Behoof for ever. And I the said  
John Faucheraud Grimké for myself  
my Heirs, Executors and  
Administrators, the said bargained Premises unto the said  
John Kean

his Executors,  
Administrator and Assigns, from and against all Persons  
shall and will warrant and for ever defend, by these Pre-  
sents. IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set  
my Hand and Seal. Dated at Charlestown  
on the first Day of March in the  
Year of our
