Abstract

Florence Price Dwyers, New Jersey - Republican, was elected to the Eighty-fifth and to the seven succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1957-January 3, 1973). Dwyer's papers include records of public service, correspondence with peers and constituents, printed material, and memorabilia, documenting her career as a member of the United States Congress.

Background Information

Acquisition

The Nancy Thompson Library at Kean College acquired the papers in 1975, from Florence Price Dwyer.

Archival Appraisal Information

A portion of the publications we deaccessioned from the collection at an unknown time. These are almost exclusively the official publications of the U.S. Government, which include about 300 bound volumes of the Congressional Record (incomplete set, 1957-1972) the United States Code (1970 ed.) Congressional

Quarterly Weekly Report (1962-1972 only) United States Statutes at Large (vols. 71-84, 1957-1971) Hearings and Reports of committees, roughly from 1959 to 1971, and a large number of pamphlets, research reports and similar publications. A few dozen books supplement this category, mostly on topics related to the legislation Mrs. Dwyer was interested in. **Only the Congressional Records are still present from this series.*

Processing Information

A name inventory was created in 1977 and is included in the collection. A folder level inventory was completed in 2014. The collection was transferred from file cabinets in the Nancy Thompson Library Learning Commons to boxes and moved to the Liberty Hall Academic Center and Exhibition Hall Special Collections Research Library & Archive in August 2019.

History

Kean College Professor Dr. Gilbert Kahn and Dwyer's Administrative Assistant, Frank Keenan suggested that Dwyer's papers be transferred to Kean College. Dwyer and the college reached an agreement and the Collection arrived at the Nancy Thompson Library in 1975. The Dwyer Room was designed and designated solely for the use of the collection by scholars in the Nancy Thompson Library. The room included file cabinets, book shelves, furniture and framed memorabilia. A card file was created in 1977, arranged alphabetically by person. Prior to 2000, the contents of the room were moved to a storage space in the library and off-site.

Scope and Content

Records of Mrs. Dwyer's public service. This seems to be the most valuable part of the collection. A complete file of all bills sponsored or co-sponsored by Mrs. Dwyer is one important segment of this group of documents. Her Reports to the People series, radio broadcasts, news releases, speeches and statements, all belong to this category. Some of these were printed in newsletter form; others were included in the texts of the

Congressional Record, and others were published as articles in various newspapers. Copious scrapbooks contain thousands of such articles, arranged in chronological order. Also, there are countless newspaper clippings on many topics that obviously interested Mrs. Dwyer.

The correspondence files constitute the third part of the Dwyer collection. Mrs. Dwyer carried on an inordinately heavy amount of correspondence; there are about 150,000 or more letters in the files. These fall into two large categories:

- a. Correspondence on legislative matters and public issues with agencies and individuals. (Campaign files belong to this area.)
- b. Correspondence with constituents who asked for some kind of help and correspondence with various agencies on their behalf.

Miscellanea, is the fourth group, which includes several hundred photographs, numerous guest books, diplomas, and awards.

Arrangement

The collection is arranged in 5 series:

1. **Public Service**

This includes Bills proposed by Dwyer, her campaign material, form letters, press releases and clippings, transcripts from Radio Reports, her newsletter: Report to the People, Scrapbooks, and Speeches.

2. **Legislative Correspondence**

Twenty file cabinets contain the correspondence on **legislative matters** with individuals and agencies. The organized pattern established by the Dwyer office staff was followed: legislative topics were kept under the name of the committees on Banking and Currency, Commerce, Government Operations, Post Office and Civil Service, Ways and Means, and so on.

3. **Constituent Correspondence**

Correspondence with **constituents who asked for assistance** (draft, taxes, social security, immigration, etc.) is arranged in alphabetical order for each year from 1957 to 1972. This and all other non-legislative correspondence with offices, agencies and with other legislators, were sorted into 15 file cabinets.

4. **Miscellaneous**

Includes photographs, paintings, and plaques.

5. **Congressional Records**

300+ hard bound, printed, books dated from January 1959-June 1972.

Biography

Short Biography

Florence Price Dwyer was a New Jersey Republican who served in Congress from January 3, 1957 through January 3, 1973. She was a critic of the Vietnam War and frequently corresponded with the residents of Essex and Union counties about legislation of the mid-twentieth century within the federal and state government. The most valuable and important parts of Congresswoman Dwyer's collection are the bills that were sponsored or co-sponsored by her, correspondences between Dwyer and others, her Reports to the People, speeches, and photographs. Dwyer was on a few committees: specifically Banking and Currency, Commerce, Government Operations, Post Office and Civil Service, and Ways and Means. In Congresswoman Dwyer's correspondences with constituents, many of them asked for her assistance on taxes, social security, and immigration.

Long Biography

Congresswoman Dwyer was born Florence Louise Price on July 4, 1902 in Reading, Pennsylvania. She attended public schools in Pennsylvania and Ohio. She also took courses at Rutgers Law School. She was a delegate to the Republican National Convention in 1944. From 1950 to 1956, Dwyer was a member of the New Jersey General Assembly. In 1957, she started her tenure as a New Jersey Republican member of the United States House of Representatives.

Throughout her career, she worked alongside women-focused business and professional groups and Republican organizations. She was a critic of the Vietnam War and frequently corresponded with the residents of Essex and Union counties about legislation of the mid-twentieth century within the federal and state government. She served on a few committees: Banking and Currency, Commerce, Government Operations, Post Office and Civil Service, and Ways and Means.

She resided in Elizabeth, New Jersey during her retirement, after finishing her last term in the House of Representatives. After her tenure was up in Congress at the start of 1973, the question of where her Congressional Papers would go was discussed. Kean College professor Dr. Gilbert Kahn and Dwyer's administrative assistant Frank Keenan suggested that Dwyer's

congressional papers be transferred to Kean College. Dwyer and Kean College reached an agreement and the collection arrived in 1975 at the Nancy Thompson Library, now known as the Nancy Thompson Learning Commons. The collection contains bills that were sponsored or co-sponsored by her, correspondences between Dwyer and others, her Reports to the People—a newsletter, speeches, and photographs.

When arriving at Kean, the Dwyer Room was designed solely for the use of the collection by scholars in what was the Nancy Thompson Library. The room included file cabinets, bookshelves, furniture, and memorabilia. A card file was created in 1977, with material arranged alphabetically by person. Prior to 2000, the contents of the room were moved to a storage space in the library, as well as off-site.

The Papers of Florence Dwyer is now housed at the Special Collections Research Library and Archive at the Liberty Hall Academic Center & Exhibition Hall, located at Kean University. Like at previous locations, the Dwyer Collection still includes records of public service, correspondences with peers and constituents, printed material, and memorabilia—all which document her long career as a member of the House of Representatives.

After serving in the United States state and federal government, Florence Dwyer died on February 29, 1976. Her interment is at St. Gertrude's Cemetery in Colonia, New Jersey.

Series Descriptions and Contents Listing

1. Public Service

22 linear feet

Includes the following sub-series, all arranged in chronological order and covering 1957-72: Bills, Campaign, Clippings, Form Letters, Press Releases, Radio Report, Report to the People, Scrapbooks, and Speeches.

Bills (1957-1972), box 1 and 2

Arranged chronologically with box 1 holding 1957-1968 and box 2 holding 1969-1972. Each drawer begins with Master Files for each Congress and Session that includes the bills introduced by Mrs. Dwyer or Mrs. Dwyer and others. The remaining folders are labeled with bill number, date, and a brief description. All folders contain bills only.

Clippings (1954-1972), boxes 3-16

Arranged in envelopes labeled by year, and sometimes by month. Clippings are loose and often folded. They include articles related to local and political issues, and Mrs. Dwyer.

Form Letters (1957-1972), box 17

Filed in 1 drawer, arranged chronologically, in a folder labeled Master Files (grouped by year), or by number/date (FL #21, 1964), which includes multiple copies. One folder contains form letters not dated.

Press Releases (1957-1972), boxes 17-19

Arranged chronologically, with multiple months in one folder. One folder not dated.

Radio Report (1962-1968), box 20

Arranged chronologically. Transcription of the regular bi-weekly radio report of Mrs. Dwyer taped for broadcast and aired on various district radio stations.

Report to the People (1955, 1957-19xx), boxes 20-21

Arranged chronologically. A bi-monthly publication by Dwyer to constituents. Includes one folder of clippings.

Scrapbooks (1953-1956, 1969-1970), moved to the end of the collection due to size, boxes 2xx-2xx

The contents contain clippings, arranged chronologically, from the Congressional Record directly related to Dwyer. Filed after the scrapbooks are Congressional Records Daily Digest, in folders grouped by year.

Speeches (1959-1972), box 22

Arranged chronologically.
