Abstract

Robert Winthrop Kean, New Jersey - Republican, was elected to the Seventy-sixth and to the nine succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1939-January 3, 1959). He was a member of the Ways and Means Committee and the House Banking and Currency Committee. Kean's papers include records of public service, correspondence with peers and constituents, printed material, and memorabilia, documenting his career as a member of the United States Congress, material related to his campaign for the United States Senate in 1958, as well as family letters during World War I, and personal business accounts.

Background Information

Acquisition

Kean University acquired the papers in May 2007, from the Liberty Hall Foundation.

Archival Appraisal Information

No materials were deaccessioned from the collection.

History and Processing Information

The Robert Winthrop Kean Congressional Papers were a gift from the Congressman's children to the Liberty Hall Foundation in the fall of 1988. The original file cabinets were delivered to Liberty Hall Museum Ice House in 1988. The appraisal stated that the collection contained 60 file drawers.

In May 2007, the Liberty Hall Foundation gifted the papers to Kean University. When Ice House construction was underway from 2008-2010, the Liberty Hall Museum Staff continued stewardship of the collection and the content of each drawer was moved into a 24" box, given a number, and the file cabinet label was taped to the box and relocated into the Wagon Shed for temporary storage. There were 80 boxes. Some boxes had two labels, because the contents of two drawers were placed in one box.

In 2010, a box and folder level inventory began. The inventory of the collection was completed in August 2011. The boxes were in no particular order. In Spring 2012, after consulting current books on organizing congressional papers, the collection was physically broken down into 4 Subgroups and arranged accordingly.

Material related to Jewish people and Israel were pulled from boxes after 2007 for education purposes. Because the original location was not noted, these folders were kept together in a box and clearly labeled in the finding aid.

Scope and Content Note

The bulk of the collection includes letters to and from constituents during Kean's time in office, 1939-1958, as well as material related to Kean's campaign for Senator in 1958.

Of special interest are files dated during World War II. The correspondence begins with strong anti-war feelings among constituents but eventually changes to support the allies. There is correspondence relating to the plight of Jews in Nazi-controlled Europe. The material also includes files related to the Post Office and Social Security Program. Kean was known for his focus on finance, taxation, and social security. Kean sought to maintain peace through the expansion of trade with the nations of the free world. He fought for a strong national defense and the development of mutual security programs with friends and allies. In fiscal policy, he guarded against inflation, minimizing living costs to protect those on fixed incomes. He worked on urban development projects by supporting school construction and labor reforms favoring collective bargaining. Most of this material is found in the first two Subgroups.

The filing system in the Administrative Assistant Files (Subgroup 1) and Legislative Assistant Files (Subgroup 2) was not always consistent. It is important to note that files were often arranged alphabetically, grouping subjects that begin with a particular letter, i.e., "Education" and "Energy," with letters from constituents or businesses whose names began with the same letter: "Mrs. Evans" and "Eaglewood, Inc.," and simply naming the entire file "E." If a specific topic cannot be found in the folder list, it may be stored under the first letter of the word or in another file, depending on who wrote the letter.

The Family Papers (filed in Subgroup 1) cover 1912-1972 and are contained in two boxes. Of special interest are the letters Kean wrote to his family during his service in World War I. Family Papers that are related to tax records (one of the two boxes) are currently restricted to direct descendants of the family, at the discretion of the archivist.

Material that contains personal material, often found in case files and Constituent Service files, are being restricted until 75 years after they were created, in order to avoid privacy issues. These will be addressed on a case by case basis until 75 years have passed. All materials from 1945 to present are openly available.

Arrangement

The collection includes 4 Series:

1. Personal and Political Files, 27 boxes

This subgroup included the more personal material, whether it's from constituent letters or family correspondence. This series includes the Administrative Assistant Files, 1940-58 (17 boxes), campaign (5 boxes), Congratulations/Condolences, Contributions, Invitations, Visitors, and Family Files. There's a smaller amount of material that includes form letters, a biography, material related to Essex County Politics, Ethnic Material, folders related to a Conference about the Aging Population, and a handful of material objects.

2. Legislative Files, 56 boxes

This subgroup includes legislative material: Bills, Voting Records, Legislative Assistant Files, Tax, and Ways and Means. The files labeled Jewish Situation, about Jewish people and Israel, are also in this subgroup.

3. Constituent Services, 14 boxes

This subgroup includes the following constituent requests: nominations for a service academy, civil service or other jobs, soldiers or their relatives requesting transfers, discharge, promotions, and information on missing people, veteran services, and visa, immigration, and citizenship assistance. Also, there are constituent requests for publications and tickets to Army-Navy football games and Presidential Inaugurations.

4. Media and Publications

This subgroup includes the following: speeches, publications, mailing lists, press releases, clippings, photographs, subject files, and one scrapbook.

Typically collections will also have a series called Office Administration; however, the arrangement of the papers did not naturally include such a series. The few files that could fall under that series were found in the Administration Assistant Files (Series 1),

the only exception was Form Letters, which are still located in Subgroup 1, but under Form Letters.

Some files were not consistently found in the same subgroup, particularly those related to Constituent Service. Constituent Service files were removed from the Personal/Official files for consistency. Files covering multiple years are filed under the earliest year.

A box of files from 1945 and 1946, related to Jewish people, Palestine, and Israel, was created prior to the inventory. There are no records stating which boxes the folders were removed from, so this material was kept together in Subgroup 2.

Series Descriptions and Contents List

Subgroup 1: Personal/Official Files

This subgroup included the more personal material, whether it's from constituent letters or family correspondence. This series includes the Administrative Assistant Files, 1940-58 (17 boxes), campaign (5 boxes), Congratulations/Condolences, Contributions, Invitations, Visitors, and Family Files. There's a smaller amount of material that includes form letters, a biography, material related to Essex County Politics, Ethnic Material, folders related to a Conference about the Aging Population, and a handful of material objects.

Administrative Assistant Files, 1940-58 (17 boxes)

Files are arranged by year, then alphabetically. A folder labeled with one letter, i.e. "C," may include constituent last name, business name, or subject that begins with that letter. A few names and subjects frequently have a folder: Edward Gaulkin (lawyer), Postal Matters, and War Department, to name a few. The majority of these files are letters, postcards, and telegrams from constituents, with responses, as well as brochures and flyers.
